

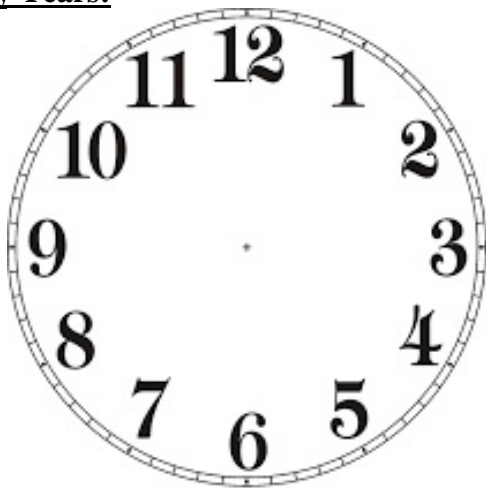

Turn Bubble Into Colour

Everyone loves blowing bubbles. This is the time of the year to do it as the high humidity makes them last longer. Make your own bubble solution $\frac{1}{2}$ cup dishwashing liquid, 2 cups water and 2 teaspoons of sugar (or a few drops of glycerine)

What is the largest bunch of bubbles you can make? Try separating your mixture into three containers. Add a few drops of food colouring to each one – make yellow, red and blue. What colour bubbles can you make?
