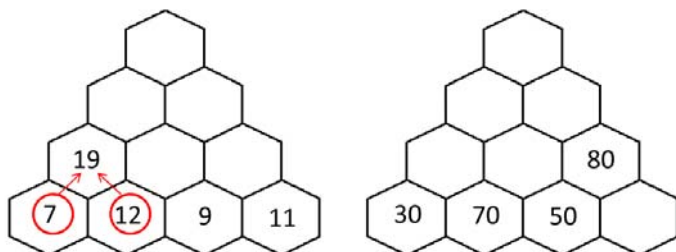

Each hexagon is made by adding up the numbers in the two hexagons below it. Fill in the missing numbers in these puzzles.

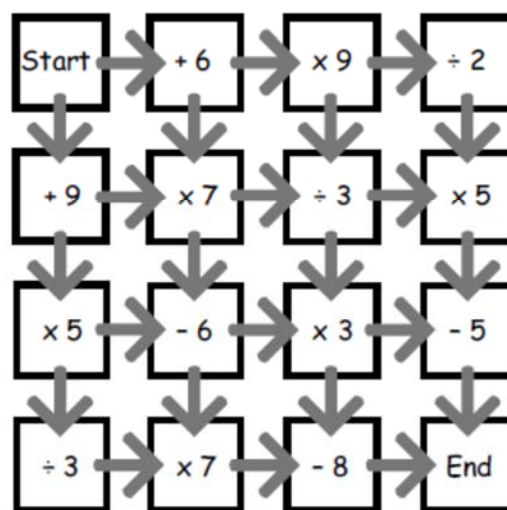

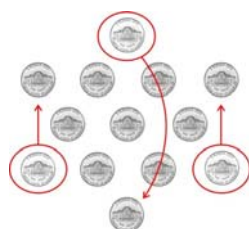
Family Fun Time:

Juggling Balls

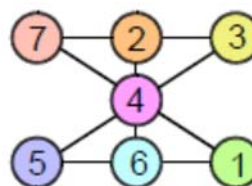
