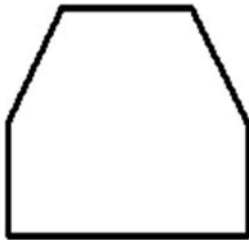
Word of the Week: Write a definition for the following.

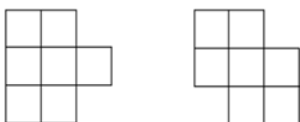
