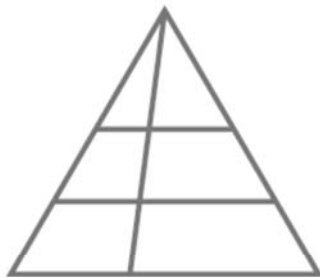
Last Week's word: Mean – usually called the average, it's the total of all the scores or amounts, divided by, how many scores or amounts there were.

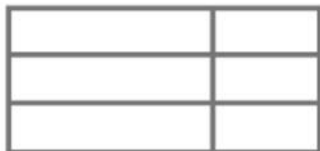
