The peel of a banana weighs about $\frac{1}{8}$ of the total weight of the banana.

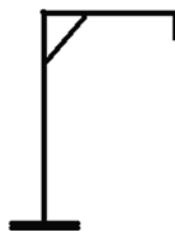
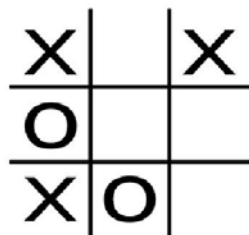
If you buy 3 kg of bananas at 1kg for \$0.60.
