

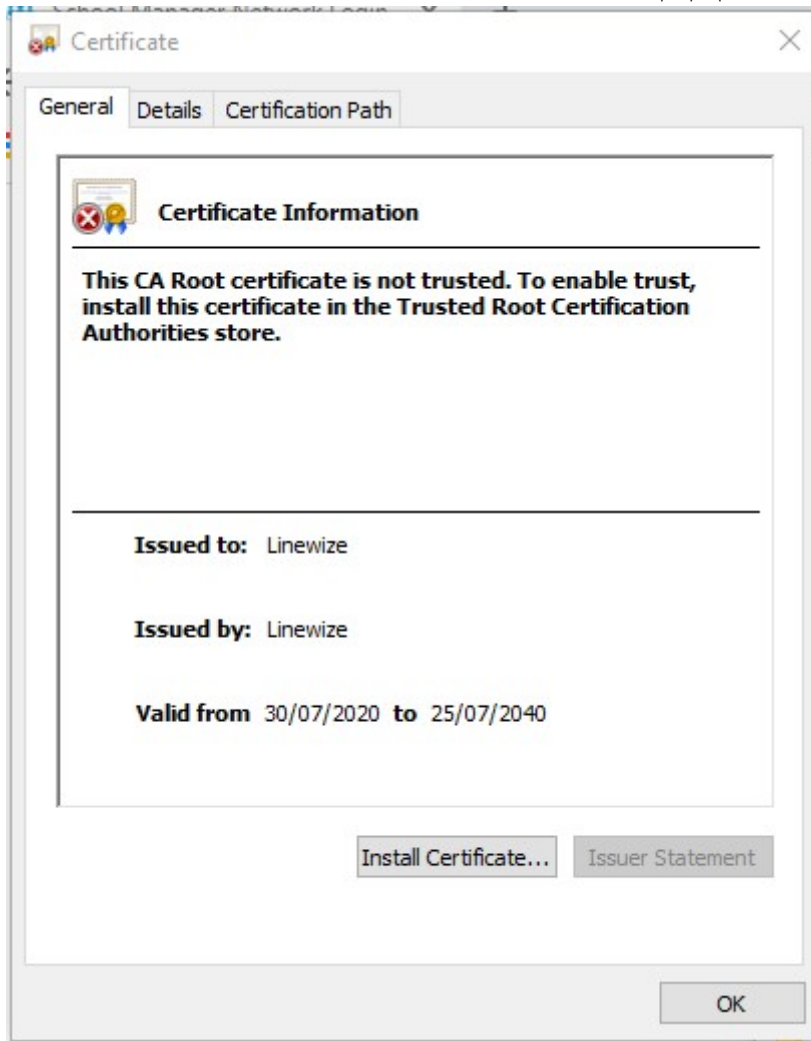
MICROSOFT WINDOWS INSTALLATION

Instruction to installing web certificate for **Windows**:

1. Open web browser and copy paste this link into the web bar <http://certs.linewize.net/> .
2. On the Main page, navigate to View Available Certificates -> Other -> Download .crt file
3. Once the file is downloaded, you should receive this file:

 **linewize.cacert.crt** 30/07/2020 11:11 PM Security Certificate 2 KB

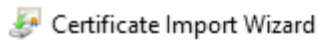
4. Double-click the linewize.cacert.crt file and a window will popup:



5. Click **Install Certificate...** and a Certificate Import Wizard Window will appear.



6. Select the Local Machine, then **Next**.

This wizard helps you copy certificates, certificate trust lists, and certificate revocation lists from your disk to a certificate store.

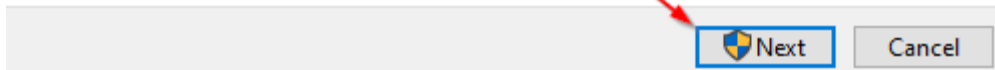
A certificate, which is issued by a certification authority, is a confirmation of your identity and contains information used to protect data or to establish secure network connections. A certificate store is the system area where certificates are kept.

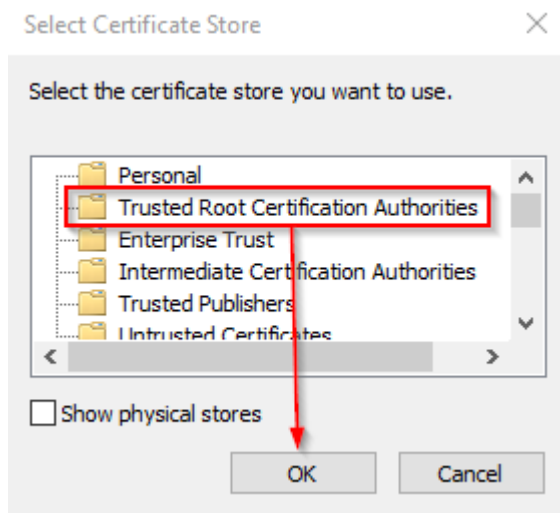
