Ben has written all the numbers he can think of.

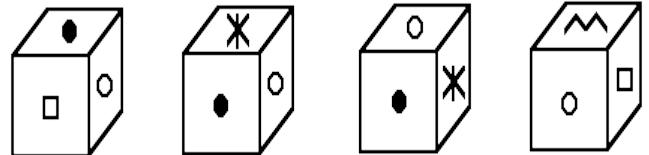
How many different numbers are there in his list?
