You may need 19 counters.



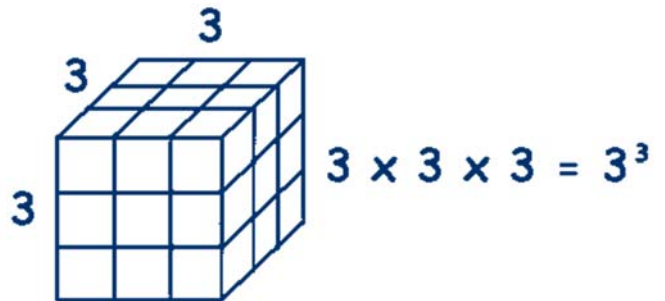
Three birds laid some eggs.
