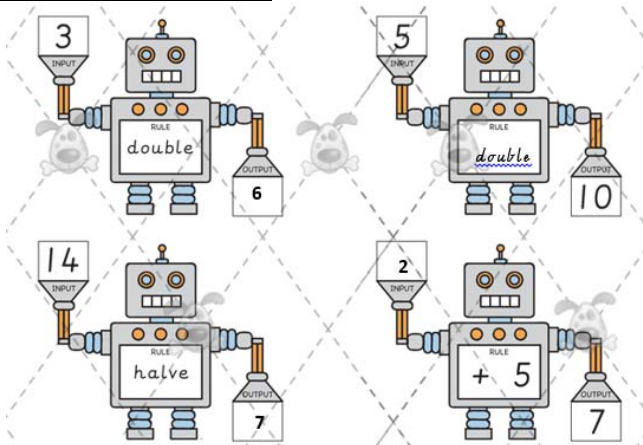
Family Fun Time:

Dive into a jigsaw puzzle

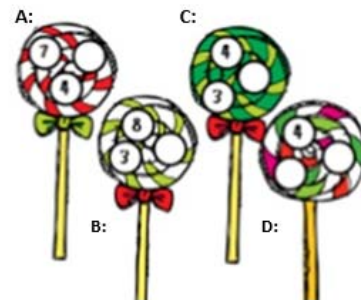
