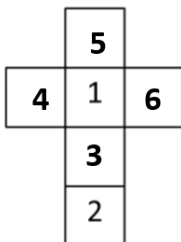

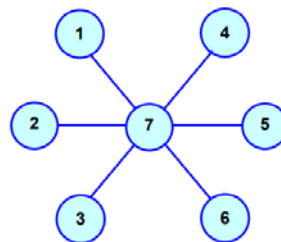
Foundation to Year 2:
