You will have so much fun making these! For this experiment you will need to set up glasses of vinegar to be the base of your volcano or just take some paper cups. Sit your cups of vinegar in a large glass dish to catch the lava. Add a few drops of food colouring to each cup and stir and add some glitter if you like. Now for the easy part. Take a scoop of baking soda and drop it right into your cups of vinegar and watch the lava happen! You could do the first one so the kids can see the reaction and then they can go from there. After the vinegar was all out of the cups just rinse and start over.
